## **SCHOOL INTRODUCTION PACKAGE**

Welcome to Lakeridge Resort's Ski, Ride and Snow Tubing School Winter Program. The duration of your activities will be no longer than five hours. Arrival and departure times are at your discretion but must be provided at the time of booking. Groups wishing to extend their day must make these arrangements at the time of booking. Please refer to the brochure for additional costs, per person, per hour.

### **Payments and Discounts:**

- 3% savings if paid in full before November 30, 2009
- \$225.00 non-refundable deposit is required to confirm date(s) booked

### **Cancellations/Refunds/Tax Receipts:**

Group cancellations must be made 24 hours in advance of your outing or no credit will be issued. To qualify for a credit based on weather problems, the resort must be notified 24 hours in advance of your arrival time, so staff can be "cancelled". For schools participating on Mondays, cancellations must be made Sunday before noon. Please speak with the on-duty manager.

No individual student refunds are provided for absences unless a doctor's note stating the student was ill/injured is provided. All personal refunds are subject to a \$5.00 administration fee. All Refunds/Tax Receipts will be issued through the school only.

### **Enclosed Forms:**

1. "**Equipment Rental Release of Liability Agreement Form**" must be double-sided with "Ski & Snowboard Ability Chart". This form **must be signed on both sides** by the parent or guardian of all students who are renting any equipment including Helmets. Students arriving at Lakeridge without submitting this form will not be able to participate.
2. "**Note to Parents Permission Form**" double-sided with "Safety Guidelines & Alpine Responsibility Code" Both parents and students must sign & acknowledge the permission waiver form in duplicate (one copy for the school and one copy for Lakeridge). This is mandated by OSBIE and OSRA.
3. "**Assumption of Risks, Release of Liability**" must be signed by all participants **including the adults**.
4. "**Advanced Skier/Snowboarder Waivers**" Participants must have this waiver on them at all time. If Ski & Ride School feels you are not at the ability to receive a double black diamond or orange sticker, you are not permitted on those runs.
5. "**Participant Attendance and Rental Forms**" This form must be filled out for all skiers and snowboarders. When groups are arriving on multiple buses, this form **must be sorted by bus &** then alphabetically by the student's names. This form must contain all of the required information, i.e. boot size, height, etc. Please note there are separate forms for supervisors and paying adult participants. Everyone must be listed on the proper form.

PARTICIPANT LIST AND WAIVERS ARE REQUIRED TWO WEEKS PRIOR TO YOUR VISIT:

The total numbers of students, teachers, participating adults, as well as all forms and waivers must be submitted two weeks prior to your visit!

**Arrival and departure times must be finalized. Failure to comply will result in delays.**

**It is imperative that you and your supervisors familiarize yourselves with the following policies & procedures:**

### Supervision

It is your responsibility as the group organizer and as a teacher in Ontario to convey & enforce the School Board/Snow Resort Safety Guidelines set out by Ontario School Boards Insurance Exchange and Ontario Ski Resorts Association. You are allotted one free Supervisor ticket for every 10 students attending.

Please note some key points listed below:

- “Students should be assigned to groups with a teacher or volunteer in charge. The teacher/volunteer supervisor will help students find the appropriate trails and will stay with the group for the day.”
- “Volunteers must be competent in the sport they are supervising.”
- “**One** supervisor is to be assigned to base camp for emergencies, and to assist with supervision over lunch. This is the only supervisory position that can be filled by a non-skier/snowboarder.”
- “**Supervisors will assemble with their group for lessons** and will assist the instructors while the students are having lessons.”
- “Following the lesson, the supervisor will take their group to the appropriate trails commensurate with the abilities of the group. The supervisor will identify the appropriate runs and trails for their group of students and **will remain in the same area as the students for the remainder of the day**”

### Upon Your Arrival

On your **first visit**, have the students remain seated on the bus. A Lakeridge Representative will greet the bus, inform the students of the lesson time and give your supervisor a package containing area lift tickets, lesson times and rental cards. It is your responsibility to hand out the package on the bus. **Note:** your bus will be greeted on the first visit only.

While waiting in the parking lot, please review the following procedures with your students:

- Students will be given their area lift tickets and rental cards on the bus.
- ***Do not layer tickets! All tickets are to go on a new wire hanger.***
- Students will enter the Lower Chalet and stow their bags in the cubbies or the coin operated lockers.
- Teachers/Supervisors will organize their groups to go outside.
- Those students who are renting equipment will be directed to the Rental Department to be outfitted with equipment (see below for rental information), then go outside.

- Upon completion of the student's lesson, the instructor will give each student a coloured sticker based on his or her skills demonstrated throughout the lesson. The sticker will be placed on the student's area lift ticket. The colour coincides with the difficulty of the trails that they are permitted to ski or snowboard on (i.e. green, blue, black).

Please note all schools coming multiple occasions will only be greeted upon their first visit. After that, a designated supervisor from your school must pick up the packages from the Ski & Ride School Office. Students are to remain on the bus until the designated supervisor returns to issue tickets & cards. It is imperative that this information be passed on to all your supervisors.

## Rental Information

IMPORTANT: Prior to entering the rental department all students and staff renting equipment must:

- Put their belongings in the cubbies or secure them in a coin-operated locker.
- Affix your area lift ticket on a new wire.
- Obtain your "yellow rental card" from your teacher/supervisor (this should happen on the bus).
- Ensure your students have **all** necessary outerwear with them, as they will be exiting the Rental Department directly outside to ski or snowboard.
- Enter the Rental Department only as directed by Lakeridge Staff.

The following procedure will be used to process participants through rentals quickly:

- Supervisors/Volunteers must be in the Rental Department to assist students before their school will be permitted to enter. This enables the students to be processed in the most efficient manner.
- Students must be sent to rentals in the following order.
  - All snowboarders.
  - Advanced & intermediate skiers.
  - Beginner skiers.
- Students will then enter rentals and pick an appropriate size of ski/board boots to wear.
- Students put their footwear in the cubbies that the rental boots were in. Expensive shoes should be locked in a locker (no valuables are to be left in rentals). **The rental department is not responsible for lost or stolen property.**
- Students will put their boots on and then proceed to line up for skis/board fitting.
- Students renting snowboards or snow blades will receive a wristband with their equipment number on it.

**Please note that all students renting snowboards and snowblades must return their equipment to the Rental Department every time they come in for a break!** This is to ensure their equipment does not go missing.

Staff, supervisors & students **must not make any changes what so ever to rental cards!** Not even misspelled names! Any and all changes must be made by the Lakeridge Administrative Office. **No exceptions.** If you are missing any rental cards, please go to the admin office.

## Lessons

- We do our best to accommodate all schools participation in the lesson programs. One time/first time occasions will have priority for lesson times to ensure a safe & fun experience for all. All other schools will be scheduled based on departure time. Feel free to call the day of your visit to find out our lesson time.
- **Switching from one activity to the other (i.e. snowboard to skiing), is not permitted once the programs have commenced.** Lessons cannot be scaled back to accommodate one student.
- Please advise your beginner students that they may have to stay in the beginner area until their skills have developed enough for them to go onto more difficult terrain. This process may take several visits.
- Please advise your beginner snowboarders that the progression is generally much slower than skiing, resulting in more weeks (approximately four) spent on the beginner area.

- If using parents as volunteers, please advise them that their own children, who are participating as students, are required to participate in a lesson, regardless of ability or parental involvement. It is required by the School Board that everyone participate in a lesson. Also advise them that their child must follow the Lakeridge sticker system even if skiing with a parent. Release forms are available at the Ski & Ride School Office if a parent wishes to take their children on hills beyond the ability that the Ski & Ride School evaluated their child at. Please note that only children with a parent or guardian skiing or riding with their child at all times can make a request for this release form.
- Students coming for multiple visits must attach area tickets to a new wire each visit. Do not layer area tickets on one wire. To receive a sticker before the lesson, students must show a lift ticket from a previous lesson with a colour sticker on it. Students will not receive a higher colour sticker until they have qualified for it during their lesson. If the students lose or cover up their lesson stickers, a new one cannot be issued until they have had another lesson.

All students must take a lesson in order to receive a sticker. If they do not have a sticker, they will not be allowed access to the chair lifts.

### **Proper Personal Equipment**

- Snowboards must have a safety leash and a full, continuous metal edge.
- Skis must have bindings that are in good working order.

### **SNOW TUBING**

Our Snow Tubing Park is a great addition to our winter sports facility. It gives everyone an opportunity to enjoy winter as long as they dress for the weather. We supply the tubes.

Snow Tubing is outlined in the OPHEA guidelines.

When booking a group for snow tubing, please remember that from Monday to Friday all groups for snow tubing have to be a minimum of 100 students, and must be booked two weeks prior to intended date.

Groups under 100 must call to inquire if there are prescheduled dates available for more than one group.

The Tube Park has been designed with your student's utmost safety in mind. We hope you will consider this thrilling experience as part of your student's winter program.

**I accept for use as is the equipment and accept full financial responsibility for the care of the equipment while it is in my possession. I will be responsible for the replacement at full value of any equipment rented, but not returned to the rental facility. I agree to return all rental equipment by the agreed time.**

**I understand that the binding system cannot guarantee the user's safety.** In downhill skiing, the binding system will not release at all times or under all circumstances where release may prevent injury or death, nor is it possible to predict every situation in which it will release. In snowboarding, cross-country skiing, snowblade use, and snow tube use the binding system will not ordinarily release during use; these bindings are not designed to release as a result of forces generated during ordinary operation.

I understand that the sports of skiing, snowboarding, snowblade use, snow tube use and other recreational activities involve and other risks of **INJURY** and **DEATH**. **I voluntarily agree to expressly assume all risks of injury or death** that may result from skiing/snowboarding/snowblade use/snow tube use, or which relate in any way to the use of this equipment.

**I AGREE TO RELEASE** Lakeridge Resort Limited, the ski/snowboard shop, its employees, owners, affiliates, agents, officers, directors, and the manufacturers and distributors of this equipment (collectively "PROVIDERS"), from all liability for injury, death, property loss and damage which results from the equipment user's participation in the sport of skiing/snowboarding/snowblade use/snow tube use, or is in any way related to use of this equipment.

I further agree to defend and indemnify PROVIDERS for any loss or damage, including any that results from claims or lawsuits for personal injury, death and property loss and damage related in any way to the use of this equipment.

**This agreement is governed by the applicable laws of this state or province. If any provision of this agreement is determined to be unenforceable, all other provisions shall be given full force and effect.**

**SKI**

Level One:	You have never skied
Level Two:	You have skied 1-3 times and are able to stop using the snowplow (wedge) technique.
Level Three:	You are able to link snowplow (wedge) turns on green terrain and have used the chairlift before.
Level Four:	You are able to link snowplow (wedge) turns on blue terrain, and show signs of skiing with your skis side by side (parallel).
Level Five:	You are able to ski with skis side by side (parallel) on blue and black terrain confidently and in control.
Level Six:	You are able to ski in control with skis side by side (parallel), maintaining rhythm and speed control on groomed black runs and are learning to apply your technique on a wider variety of terrain and snow conditions.

**SNOWBOARD**

Level One:	You have never snowboarded before.
Level Two:	You can stop and control your speed, sliding to the left and right.
Level Three:	You are able to slide left and right in control on both edges and complete an independent heel and toe turn on gentle green terrain.
Level Four:	You are able to complete a linked toe and heel turn on gentle green terrain and looking towards easy blue terrain.
Level Five:	You are able to complete linked turns on toe and heel side on green and blue terrain.
Level Six:	You are able to complete linked turns with minimal traverse comfortably on all blue terrain and easy black terrain.

PERMISSION FORM

NOTE TO PARENTS & STUDENTS:
(Please Read Carefully)

(School Name) is arranging a trip for students to go to Lakeridge Resort to ski, snowboard, snowblade or snow tube. This signed form is required for all students who wish to participate in this snow sport education program. It should be understood that the purpose of the excursion is educational.

Inherent Risk

Skiing, snowboarding or snowtubing is a sport with physical demands, dangers, hazards and inherent risks which are beyond the control of Lakeridge Resort and (School Board), including but not limited to, boarding, riding and disembarking ski lifts; failure of ski lifts; changing weather conditions; variation or steepness in terrain; exposed rock, earth, ice, trees or other natural objects; the condition of snow or ice on or beneath the skiing surface; changes or variations in the skiing surface or subsurface, including changes due to man-made or artificial snow; impact with ski lift towers or snow making or snow grooming equipment or other structures of objects used in connection with skiing or ski racing; impact or collision with other skiers, failure to ski safely or within one's own ability or within designated areas; and the negligence of other skiers or riders. The risks, dangers and hazards referred to above exist throughout the Ski Area and many are unmarked. The back of this form includes an actual area ticket waiver, please read this carefully before giving your child permission to participate. Participants will assume the inherent risks of the sport. Following all rules and procedures can reduce the risk of injury. Failure to follow rules will result in the student losing their lift ticket and future resort privileges.

Equipment

Lakeridge Resort provides rental equipment. Bindings on equipment reduce the risk of injury when falling. The will not release under all circumstances and they do not guarantee safety in all cases. Parents must accept the responsibility for equipment that is lost or damaged (other than reasonable wear and tear). Bindings on snowboards and snowblades are NOT designed to release during falls.

Your Responsibility Code (see back of form) The Ontario Snow Resorts Association has produced a Responsibility Code that Lakeridge Resort, and (School Board) requires you to know & obey. Skiers/Snowboarders and snowbladers must always be in control and able to stop and change direction to avoid collisions with people or objects. Lakeridge Resort may revoke a ski ticket for violation of the code or other unacceptable conduct.

**ALPINE RESPONSIBILITY CODE**

There are elements of risk that common sense and personal awareness can help reduce regardless of how you decide to use the slopes. Always show courtesy to others. Please adhere to the code listed below and share with others the responsibility for a safe outdoor experience.

1. Always stay in control. You must be able to stop or avoid other people and objects.
2. People ahead of you have the right-of-way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.
3. Do not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.
4. Before starting downhill or merging onto a trail, look uphill and yield to others.
5. If you are involved in or witness a collision or accident, you must remain at the scene and identify yourself to the Ski Patrol.
6. Always use proper devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
7. Observe and obey all posted signs and warnings.
8. Keep off closed trails and closed areas.
9. You must not use lifts or terrain if your ability is impaired through the use of alcohol or drugs.
10. You must have sufficient physical dexterity, ability and knowledge to safely load, ride and unload lifts. If in doubt, ask the lift attendant.

I am aware that skiing/snowboarding/snow blading and snowtubing involves many inherent risks, dangers and hazards, including but not limited to , boarding, riding and disembarking ski lifts; failure of ski lifts; changing weather conditions; variation or steepness in terrain; exposed rock, earth, ice, trees or other natural objects; the condition of snow or ice on or beneath the skiing surface; changes or variations in the skiing surface or subsurface, including changes due to man-made or artificial snow; streams and creeks and exposed holes in the snowpack above streams or creeks; impact with ski lift towers or snow making or snow grooming equipment or other structures or objects used in connection with skiing or ski racing; impact or collision with other skiers, the failure to ski safely or within one's own ability or within designated areas; negligence of other skiers and; negligence on the part of the Ski Area or its Staff. I am also aware that the risks, dangers and hazards referred to above exist throughout the Ski Area and that many are unmarked. I freely accept and fully assume all such risks, dangers and hazards and the possibility of personal injury, death, property damage or loss, resulting therefrom.

**RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS & INDEMNITY AGREEMENT**

In consideration of LAKERIDGE RESORT LIMITED permitting the use of their ski lifts, ski runs, restaurants, parking and other facilities (hereinafter referred to as "the skiing facilities") I hereby agree as follows:

1. TO WAIVE ANY AND ALL CLAIMS that I have or may in the future have against LAKERIDGE RESORT LIMITED and its Directors, Officers, Employees, Agents and Representatives, (All of whom are hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Releases");
2. TO RELEASE THE RELEASEES from any and all liability for any loss, damage, injury or expense that I may suffer or that my next of kin may suffer as a result of my use of the skiing facilities, due to any cause whatsoever, INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE, BREACH OF CONTRACT, BREACH OF STATUTORY DUTY OF CARE, AND/OR BREACH OF THE OCCUPIER'S LIABILITY ACT, R.S.O. 1990 c.0.2. ON THE PART OF THE RELEASEES.
3. TO HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY THE RELEASEES from any and all liability for any property damage or personal injury to any third party, resulting from my use of the skiing facilities; and
4. That this agreement shall be effective and binding upon my heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators and assigns, in the event of my death.

In entering into this Agreement, I am not relying upon any oral or written representations or statements made by the Releases other than what is set forth in this Agreement.

Addendum: It is understood and agreed that this Agreement shall not apply in respect of injuries resulting from mechanical breakdown or failure of ski lifts or tows, or any related equipment, resulting from the negligence of Lakeridge Resort Limited, its Employees, Agents and Representatives.

I have read and understood this Agreement prior to signing it, and I am aware that by signing this Agreement I am waiving certain legal rights which I or my heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators and assigns may have against the Releases.
