Snow Tubing Policies

1. All participants must have a ticket. All tickets are valid only on the day indicated.
2. All participants must follow all directions given by Lakeridge Staff. Failure to do so will result in the loss of your tubing privileges.
3. Each participant must ride in individual tubes.
4. Tubes may be allowed to go down in groups depending on conditions. Group size is determined by chute speed.
5. All minor children are the responsibility of designated group supervisors, parents or legal guardians. Our staff will not be responsible for supervising or monitoring children activity in the park.
6. Tubing is allowed only when Lakeridge personnel are present.
7. Tubing is not allowed anywhere on Lakeridge Resort property except for the Tube Park Chutes. Tubing is not permitted on ski slopes.
8. Tubing is only permitted in tubes provided by Lakeridge Resort.
9. Horseplay of any kind such as but not limited to, snowball throwing, sliding on tubes on walkways, pushing, climbing on fences and embankments or pulling snow-tubes with passengers is not permitted at any time. Offenders will be asked to leave the premises.
10. Tubing operations may be stopped at any time due to weather, safety concerns or lack of enough participants.
11. Do not use the Tube Park if your ability is impaired through the use of alcohol or drugs.

Snow Tube Park Procedures

1. Read all warning and signage. Your participation confirms your acceptance of all Rules, Regulations, Warnings and Cautions.
2. Pick up tube at coral: one tube is required for each participant.
3. Line up at the tube lift.
4. Identify yourself to the attendant and surrender a ticket or show your Tube pass from your school/group. People unfamiliar with the park and its use must ask the attendant for help.
5. Load the Lift. Surrender the ringed end of the tube leash to the lift attendant. Sit in the tube, facing down hill.
6. **IF SNOW-TUBE BECOMES UNATTACHED FROM THE LIFT YOU MUST ROLL OUT OF YOUR TUBE IMMEDIATELY!!!! ENSURE YOUR CHILDREN UNDERSTAND THIS SAFETY RULE, FAILURE TO EXIT A DETACHED TUBE CAN RESULT IN SERIOUS INJURY.**
7. When your tube has been unattached by our attendant at the top of the tube tow you must wait for the tube to come to a natural stop and then get out of the tube and move immediately out of the area and proceed to the tube chutes. **DO NOT LINGER** in the lift area.
8. Identify yourself to the tube park chute staff at the top of the hill.

9. Follow attendant's instructions. If accompanying children 4-5 years old, you must hold on to your child's tube when riding down the chute. You must hold on to the tube until you come to a full stop.
10. Place the tube leash and ring inside the tube. Sit in the tube with your legs out in front of your tube. Secure all loose items such as hats. Raise your backside up slightly off of the bottom of the tube. Hold onto the handles.
11. Descend the tube park chute only when advised that it is safe to do so. **DO NOT DESCEND UNTIL YOUR CHUTE IS CLEAR.**
12. Avoid any contact with chute walls
13. When your tube has stopped completely, get up out of the tube and clear the area immediately. Follow all instructions from park employees.
14. **DO NOT CROSS OTHER TUBE CHUTES!!! STAY IN YOUR LANE UNTIL DIRECTED WHERE TO EXIT.**
15. Carry or pull your tube back to the tube tow and return it to the coral or staff on duty, if you're finished.
16. **DO NOT RIDE IN TUBES ON THE WALKWAYS; DO NOT PULL PASSENGERS IN TUBES ON WALKWAYS.**
17. Tickets/Passes must be used on the day purchased or designated.
